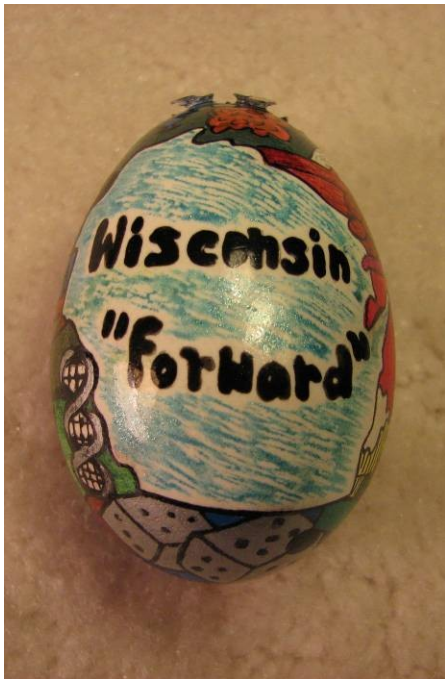

The front of the egg bears a map outline, the **name Wisconsin**, and the **motto “Forward.”** The **blue** everywhere on the egg indicates the importance to the state of the many lakes, rivers and the Great Lakes.

To the right of the map are icons for **logging**, the state animal the **badger**, **paper**, **snowflakes**, a **beer mug**, a **tractor**, the state beverage **milk**, **Ice cream** and **cheese**.

To the left of the map are icons for the state domestic animal the **dairy cow**, **evergreen trees** and fall-color state tree **sugar maple tree**, a **canoe**, the state grain **corn**, **DNA** for genetic research, and the state flower the **wood violet**.





Further to the left of the map are icons of **maple sugaring**, the state fish the **muskie**, **Ojibwe Indian moccasins**, an **Indian dreamcatcher**, **mallard duck**, **icicles**, and the state fruit **cranberries**.



Going further to the left, we come back to the icons for cheese, ice cream and snowflakes.



The bottom of the egg shows icons for an **Indian basket**, the state wildlife animal the **whitetail deer**, and **dice** representing the Indian casinos.



The top of the egg bears icons for pine trees, deciduous trees, and a large metallic snowflake.
